When we reflect on The Red Devils' impact in 2011, we recall vivid memories of the families we touched and the nurses, social workers, and physicians whose compassion and dedication allowed us to improve the quality of life for so many over the course of the year. We give thanks, also, to the hundreds of volunteers who help in the office and at venues statewide, and to our generous donors—individuals, foundations, businesses, and organizations—without whom none of the differences we make in families' lives would be possible.

We are pleased to offer this report highlighting our accomplishments in 2011. With your help, we made an immediate and profound impact on the lives of 688 breast cancer families living in Maryland. Because of you, families were able to remain in their homes, mothers' worries about feeding their families were dissipated, patients entered into or remained in treatment and for many, hope replaced despair.

Every day we are reminded how much your support means to so many. Without your unwavering investments in our mission through the years, the breast cancer journeys of so many families would have been sadly different.

In 2011, The Red Devils served its mission of funding support services to improve the quality of life for breast cancer patients and their families by investing \$287,831 in our three core program areas: Treatment Transportation, Family Support, and Medical Services and Treatment-Related Therapies.

Family Support included meals and groceries, house cleaning, utilities, rent, mortgages, child care, yard work, auto insurance, retail gift card, and home care.

MEALS AND GROCERIES

167 patients made requests for meal deliveries.

We partnered with Moveable Feast, Super Suppers, The Dinner Company, Top Banana and Dream Dinners to provide prepared meals and bags of groceries. Gift cards to groceries stores also were provided to families.

"I felt amazing when my nurse navigator presented me with my Giant card to provide me with groceries. We went the dam day and going to the market made me feel awesome to be able to purchase good foods for me to eat."

HOUSE CLEANING

323 house cleanings were provided to 141 patients. In addition to the 21 Merry Maids

offices, we also worked with MaidPro (Talbot County), Dust Busters (Carroll County), Service Master, Stress Cleaning (Stockton) and Prestige Cleaning in Western Maryland.

"Having my house cleaned gave me the energy to more myself. You should be extremely proud to be associated with helping individuals when they can't help themselves. You give energy where often times there [is] little or none."

HOUSING STABILITY

We invested \$17,000 to assist families with rent and mortgage payments. As one of our hospital coordinators commented,

"Several patients undergoing treatment were served eviction notices. Most had funds but were short of the full amount required to avoid eviction. The Red Devils provided the remaining amount due which enabled our patients and their families to remain in their homes."

Treatment Transportation is very crucial component in facilitating access to treatment.

TRANSPORTATION

Last year, 224 patients collectively received 1,142 rides for medical appointments from SafeRide, Regency Cab, Action Taxi, Allegheny Transit, GHS Transportation, and Gene's Taxi. Transportation funds also were used to purchase gas cards, cab vouchers, and parking and bus passes.

"I could not afford to go to my treatments without your support. You were a God send for me as I didn't know what I was going to do. Thank you, thank you, thank you!"

Medical Services and Treatment– Related Therapies included assistance with chemotherapy and radiation treatments, medical co-payments and insurance premiums, complementary therapies, lymphedema therapies and supplies, medical equipment and other one-time critical needs.

COMPLEMENTARY THERAPIES

94 patients received massage, acupuncture, reiki, healing touch, yoga, and nutritional counseling.

"Thanks to everyone behind The Red Devils to come up with an idea that is so beneficial to women with cancer then their lives are spinning out of control. During this difficult time that I am experiencing with my chemo, words aren't enough to thank you for the opportunity to have a couple of massages with caregivers that are compassionate and dedicated to their jobs."

CO-PAYS AND MEDICAL SERVICES

150 patients had co-payments, hospital and doctor bills, prescriptions, dental services, wigs, mastectomy bras, and a home response unit covered by The Red Devils.

We measure the immediate impact of our treatment support not only by the number of families we help every year, but also by their assessment of the difference we make in their quality of life. In 2011, patients who participated in our quality of life surveys rated prescription co-payments and house cleaning as the most beneficial to them, followed closely by meals and groceries, and treatment transportation.

When asked how our treatment support affected their stress reduction, optimism, sense of normalcy, self-esteem, and peach of mind, all responded that The Red Devils played an "extremely positive" or "positive" role in their breast cancer journey.

"In a financially difficult time with all kinds of resources drying up for our patients, The Red Devils has been a lifeline. As a social worker I do not have one other agency that compares to the responsiveness to patients' needs and the ease with which I can refer and access their services."






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
