

FROM THE PRESIDENT and EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

On behalf of our board of directors and staff, we are pleased to present The Red Devils 2010 Annual Report. This report covers our work from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010. Throughout



the year, we shared with you stories of challenges and triumph, fear and optimism, and desperation and generosity. You may recall reading about the young daughter who finds comfort in the scrapbook her mother was able to create before dying from breast cancer. Who could forget the perseverance and inspiring spirits of our Nine Ladies Dancing? How about the neighborhood of children who collected and donated "Pennies from Heaven" or the students at schools across the state who held events and made blankets, all to benefit our patients?

We continue to be moved each and every day by the profound impact your funding allows us to make on the quality of life for so many in our community. 2010 marked our eighth year supporting breast cancer patients and their families, and saw us continue the trend of investing more in support services than the preceding year and increasing the number of patients benefiting from our funding. In 2010, we touched the lives of 600 patients and spent \$210,896 to fund transportation to treatment, family support needs, and medical and treatment related costs.

As always, our fidelity to the trust you place in us includes not only our laser-like focus on fulfilling our mission, but also adhering to the highest standards and best practices for non-profit management and leadership. In 2010 we refreshed our strategic plan with new goals, objectives, and

"I can do whatever treatment is recommended even knowing it will take a year to complete... My only concern is my two-year-old daughter. She doesn't understand why Mommy needs to rest, or when I'm distracted by nausea. The Red Devils paid for 11 weeks, during my chemotherapy, of a licensed neighborhood day care where they speak my daughter's language. From the start she was happy to go there and I'm getting the rest and support I need. This is just one of the many resources The Red Devils helped my family of five with that has made me so happy."



OUR SUPPORT SERVICES

In 2010, The Red Devils served our mission of funding support services to improve the quality of life for breast cancer patients and their families by assisting 600 patients, and investing \$295,478 in program-related activities to fund transportation for treatments, family support needs, and medical services and treatment-related therapies. As always, we rely on the hands-on expertise of our hospital partners to determine how best our limited funding can benefit their patients.

TRANSPORTATION FOR TREATMENTS

We respond to patients' on-going or one-time needs for transportation by funding rides provided by a host of partners, including sedan companies, taxis, and public transportation; and by purchasing gas cards, bus passes and parking vouchers so that patients able to do so could afford to drive themselves. In 2010, we invested \$56,658 and funded rides for 194 patients.

"My young patient is receiving chemotherapy before her initial surgery. Then she will have surgery followed by more chemotherapy. She is a single mom with no current income, so these gas cards are allowing her to get to her appointments!"

FAMILY SUPPORT

The Red Devils supported breast cancer families by funding meals and groceries, house cleaning, utilities and rent, telephone bills, child care and day camp, and family-oriented outings through our Fun Fund. In 2010, our investment in family support needs totaled \$84,348, to the benefit of more than 400 families.

"I am quite excited about The Red Devils move into Montgomery and Prince George's counties. As a social worker, I frequently encounter cancer patients who are struggling to pay for their expensive medications, to get a ride to a doctor's office or for a treatment, or merely to cope with everyday living while dealing with fatigue, nausea or other overwhelming side effects of treatment. We need to treat the whole person (and sometimes the family that is affected) not just the cancer. The Red Devils is making it possible for people with cancer to get the help that they need when they need it."





OUR SUPPORT SERVICES



MEDICAL SERVICES AND TREATMENT-RELATED THERAPIES

"My patient is a 40 year old single mom with four children who is post both bilateral mastectomy and oophorectomy with a high risk for breast cancer recurrence and other secondary cancers. She received chemotherapy first then surgery. Her health insurance is not great and she has close to \$10,000 in co-insurance payments that are due to her oncologist who treated her regardless of her ability to pay. There have been many hardships and treatment side effects that warrant her needing groceries, maid service and some assistance with co-pays."

This and hundreds of similar inquiries did not go unanswered in 2010. During the year, The Red Devils received and responded to 389 requests for medical assistance with doctors' bills, co-payments, insurance premiums, wigs, oxygen in the home, and complementary therapies, collectively totaling \$69,596.

"It wasn't just a recovery for me, it was an experience. Everyone on the oncology team worked so diligently for me. But, when I wasn't able to pay for my prescription, The Red Devils came to my rescue, and paid the full amount. I'll always be grateful for that."





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
